

Wayne Fischer

Wayne Fischer resides from Arlington, SD. Wayne worked at a community bank in South Dakota for 44 years, and has been married to his wife Melanie for 46 years. Wayne has 4 children with 11 grandchildren, and soon to be 12. Wayne is a lifelong pigeon and poultry fancier, and got started in pigeons from his father, and in bantams from Jim Carter, both from Ada, MN. He has been a SD State Fair poultry employee since 1993, 23 years as the Superintendent while balancing time spent as the Assistant Superintendent. Wayne is also a member of the SD State 4-H Poultry Committee. He helped start the National Pigeon Association "Legacy Fund Trust". This fund is a permanent endowment to promote pigeons worldwide. Wayne has been a poultry judge for both open and 4-H for over 30 years. HE has also judged numerous county fairs, Achievement Days, and open class pigeon shows in the states of SD, ND, MN and IA, while judging at state fairs of SD, ND, MN, IA and AKSARBEN broiler show. He has awards with American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association Master Exhibitor award, and MN State Pigeon Association Lifetime Achievement Award. He has raised a wide range of Large Fowl, Bantam's, Waterfowl, Pigeons, and Game Birds, while specializing in Fantail pigeons, Rosecomb, and Japanese Bantam's.

Pete Dempsey

Pete Dempsey is from Jefferson, Wisconsin. Pete has been raising and showing exhibition poultry and pigeons for over 60 years. Primarily ducks, geese and pigeons. Pete has also raised several breeds of chickens and bantams in the past. Pete has earned master breeder awards in 3 breeds of pigeons and several breeds of ducks and geese. Pete has exhibited birds in several states and supplied birds to people across the country. He received his judging license from the University of Wisconsin over 50 years ago, and has judged in several states at state fairs, county fairs, poultry shows and pigeon shows.

Bart Pals is from Mason City, Iowa. Bart has been a licensed American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association licensed judge for 35 years. Bart has had the privilege of judging across the United States and Canada, also Bermuda. Most recently judging the Alaska State Fair in Fairbanks. 


