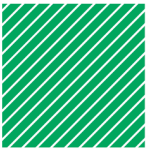

2024 MINNESOTA STATE FAIR 4-H BEEF SHOW JUDGES

Parker Henley, 4-H Beef Show Judge

Parker Henley from Stillwater, Oklahoma currently serves as the livestock judging team coach and Dr. Robert "Bob" Totusek Endowed Chair Fellow at Oklahoma State University. Parker coached the 2021, 2022 and, 2023 National Champion Livestock Judging Team and was named the "Coach of the Year" in 21 and 22 and was named 2023 Best of the Barns Best Sr. College Livestock Judging Team Coach. Currently, along with coaching, Parker serves as an extension specialist focused in beef cattle management and youth livestock selection and education. He received his masters and PhD from the University of Illinois while focusing his research in nutrition and management strategies for heifer and bull development systems. Parker was a member of the livestock judging team at Butler Community College and Kansas State University where he received a bachelor's degree in Animal Science. Parker was raised in central Missouri where he and family still raise Angus and Charolais cattle. Parker and his family have bred or exhibited several national or reserve national champion Charolais cattle. Parker and his wife Christy have two children, Norman and Charlotte. Parker has judged livestock shows in 33 states, Canada, and Mexico.

Ashley Recknor, 4-H Beef Showmanship Judge

Ashley currently lives in Britt, Iowa with her husband Jess and their daughter Rylan on their family farm. Ashley is the Specialty Services Officer overseeing multiple clinics and purchasing teams at Iowa Specialty Hospital and Clinics in Clarion and Belmond, IA. In addition, Ashley along with her family own and operate Purple Ribbon Beef, where they market their beef direct to consumers through multiple farmers markets, local coops, and nationwide shipping weekly. Ashley grew up showing Shorthorn and Simmental cattle all across the country and was fortunate to be very successful in her show ring career. She has previously judged at the Charolais Junior Nationals, National Junior Simmental Show, North Central Simmental Regional, Iowa State Fair 4-H Show, and the Iowa Beef Expo.

Lindsey Noll, 4-H Dairy Steer Judge

Lindsey Noll from Fort Wayne, Indiana will serve as the 4-H Dairy Steer Judge in 2024. Lindsey was a ten year 4-H member showing livestock at County and State levels. Her passion has always been showing and judging dairy beef and beef showmanship. She is the fourth generation on the family grain and feedlot operation in northeast Indiana. She enjoys judging youth livestock shows and giving back to the 4-H community throughout the Midwest. Lindsey is a 5th grade teacher at Perry Hill Elementary. She and her husband Matt have three children, Dexter, Oakley, and Harper.

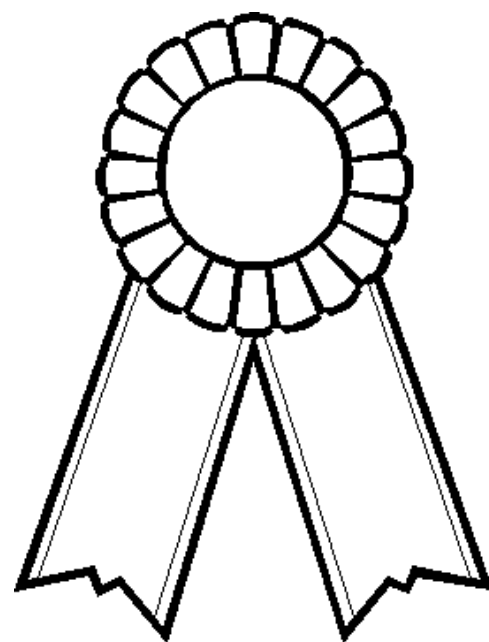

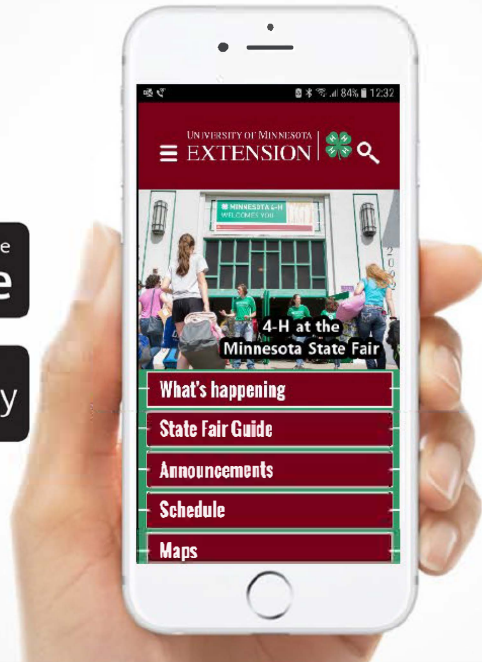
