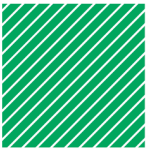

Clay Kretzmeier

Clay Kretzmeier is from Fowler, IN. Clay judged livestock at Illinois Central College then transferred to Purdue University to continue judging and obtain a Bachelor's Degree in Ag Sales and Marketing. He has judged all species of livestock in 15 states. Currently, Clay is the Assistant Livestock Judging Coach at Purdue University and works on his family's row crop farm. He owns and operates Kretzmeier Showpigs with the assistance of his family where they run a dozen Chester, Spot, and Crossbred sows.

Brant Smith

Brant grew up in Michigantown, Indiana on his family's diversified row crop and hog farm. He began judging on his FFA team, which led him to collegiate opportunities. He graduated from Black Hawk East and transferred to Western Illinois University to earn his Ag Business Degree. Brant was a competitive member on the judging team at each respective school. Brant has been a District Sales Manager for Wyffels Hybrids for eleven years. He currently resides in northern Illinois with his wife and two kids. They look forward to raising their kids in the show ring!

Walker McDermott

Walker McDermott is from Wiota, Iowa. He grew up on an Angus and Simmental cow/calf operation, with the goal of raising competitive cattle for the show ring. Walker has been in the showring since the age of four, showing cattle, pigs, sheep, and goats at state and national levels across the United States. He attended Iowa State University with a double major in Agricultural Studies and Ag Business with a minor in Agronomy. Walker has judged shows across the Midwest with highlights of judging at the Iowa and Nebraska State Fairs. He currently helps run Refresh Livestock with his sister and brother-in-law, selling livestock to youth in the industry, while also running his livestock photography business WM Media.

Justin Mosher

Justin Mosher currently resides in Secor, Illinois with his wife and three daughters. There they run Blue Mountain Livestock, a 15-20 sow show pig operation. He is also heavily involved with helping families across the country find pigs and cattle for county, state, and national level shows. Justin attended Hutchinson Community College and Kansas State University where he was on highly competitive livestock judging teams at each institution. Justin grew up in western Colorado on a cow-calf cattle operation and showed multiple species growing up! He is currently the Livestock Judging Coach & Animal Activities Specialist at Joliet Junior College. Justin has had the privilege to judge shows across the country and is grateful for every opportunity he gets to work with youth and continue to share his passion for this industry.

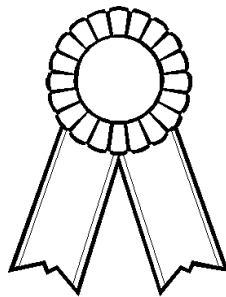
