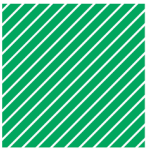

While at Iowa State he was a member of the 2020 livestock judging team and had numerous top ten finishes as an individual. 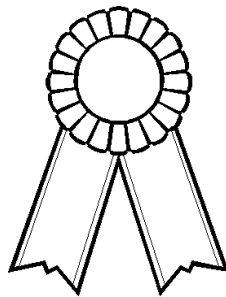
