## Minnesota State Fair Fundraising Opportunities

### Sanitation, Parking, Park & Ride

Listed below are fundraising opportunities that are currently available during the 12 days of the Great Minnesota Get-Together, August 24<sup>th</sup> to September 4<sup>th</sup>.

#### Sanitation

Pull trash bags and picking up trash off the grounds.

12-hour shifts – 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. available all 12 days of the fair

Size of the group determines the size of the area, which equals compensation

- 10+ participants - \$1000      40+ participants - \$4000
- 20+ participants - \$2000      50+ participants - \$5000
- 30+ participants - \$3000      60+ participants - \$6000

Example: ROTC groups have 100 people working during the fair. They receive \$5000/day. They work 6 of the 12 days of the fair!

#### Park & Ride

Work in one of our Park & Ride lots located around the metro area directing cars to parking spaces

Shift times: 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., 3-11 p.m. (times vary)

- **Requires a minimum of 4-day commitment**
- Need a minimum of 5-10 participants per day/shift (depends on lot size)
- Must have adult leadership supervision during all hours of the shift
- Daily sign-in sheets
- Flat rate is based on the size of the lot, number of people, and number of hours worked.
- Compensation range is \$1,450\* - \$9,180\*
  - 5 people, 8 hours, 4 days and 5 people, 17 hours, 12 days, respectively

#### Parking

Working in one of the various lots around the fairgrounds directing cars to parking areas.

- **A 4-day minimum commitment is preferred.**
- Shift times: 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- Need a minimum of 5-7 participants per day/shift (depends on lot size)
- Compensation: 2-8 p.m., 4 days (5 participants) = \$1,100
- 6 a.m. to 2 p.m., 4 days, (7 participants) = \$2,000
- One check (no withholdings) made payable to the name on the W-9 form submitted along with the volunteer agreement.

**\*Please note: Actual dollar amounts listed above may vary. Actual compensation is based on the number of people and hours, as well as the type of position and size of the area assigned.**
