Hands-Only CPR & AEDs Save Lives

In just a few minutes, learn skills that can save lives.

Hands-Only CPR: Two steps can double or triple a person's chance of survival. As a bystander, you can:

1. Call 911
2. Push hard & fast in the center of the chest

AED: Using an AED within the first three minutes of sudden cardiac arrest increases the survival rate by over 80 percent. Learn the simplicity of using an AED.

Find out more about Hands-Only CPR and AEDs and visit with certified trainers and cardiac arrest survivors at the tent on Carnes Avenue, east of the Grandstand Ramp. Brought to you by the American Heart Association and the Center for Resuscitation Medicine at the University of Minnesota. National CPR and AED Awareness Week is June 1-7.
