

# MINNESOTA STATE FAIR

## 2018 Minnesota State Fair Scholarship Program

- Up to 20 scholarships of \$1,000 each will be made available to young adults from greater Minnesota or enrolled in an agriculture program in 2017-2018. A qualified committee will review applications and select the recipients. Scholarship recipients will be notified by telephone of their award between Aug. 11-14, 2018.
- Announcement of the recipients will be made:
  - Friday, Aug. 24 at the 4-H Beef Championship held in the Lee & Rose Warner Coliseum, and
  - Monday, Sept. 3 at the FFA Awards Program held in Compeer Arena.

### Requirements for Consideration

- Application **must** indicate **anticipated participation in the current year's Minnesota State Fair**.
- Rural residency **or** enrollment in an agriculture program required.
- Must be a resident of Minnesota
- Applicant must be a high school graduate as of the current year's fair.
- Applicant must be attending or planning to attend a post secondary school in the current year. No restrictions as to course of study or choice of school.
- Incomplete applications or applications without a transcript will not be considered.
- Completed applications and transcripts must be **received** on or before **4:30 p.m. Aug. 3, 2018**.
- Previous Minnesota State Fair Scholarship recipients are ineligible to enter.

### Judging Guidelines

The State Fair representative will initially review the applications to ensure applicants meet minimum requirements. Copies of the applications will be sent to each committee member.

- Applications will be ranked by each committee member in priority order. Individual rankings of each member will be combined to arrive at a consensus as to the top candidates and resultant number of recipients.
- Each of the five (5) application criteria will be given 20% consideration for a total possible score of 100.
- The State Fair representative will vote only in case of ties.

## Submission Requirements

- Applications must be completed using the online scholarship application at <https://goo.gl/UmuA2m>.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applications or transcripts received after the deadline will **not** be considered.
- Do not submit multiple applications.
- No application materials will be returned.
- If you would like confirmation that your transcript was received, we suggest you send your transcript via certified mail, or some other delivery service.

- Recipients will be notified by telephone of award between Aug. 11-14, 2018.
- Payment will be made when **proof of paid tuition** (paid tuition includes grants, scholarships, or cash payments) is made to the Minnesota State Fair; **do not send transcript or class schedule**. Recipients must claim their scholarship before the first day of next year's fair, **Aug. 22, 2019**; payment will be made to applicant and sent to address listed on the application.
